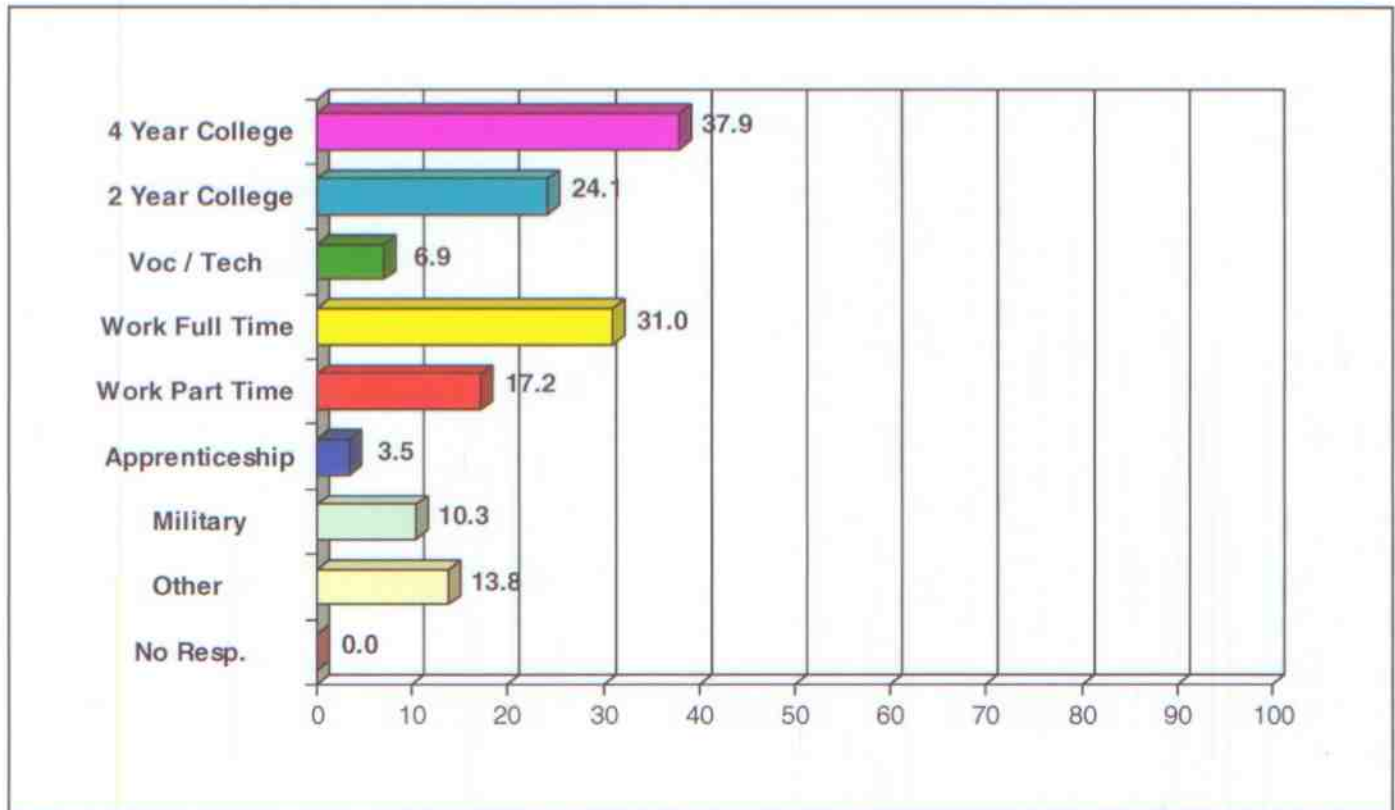

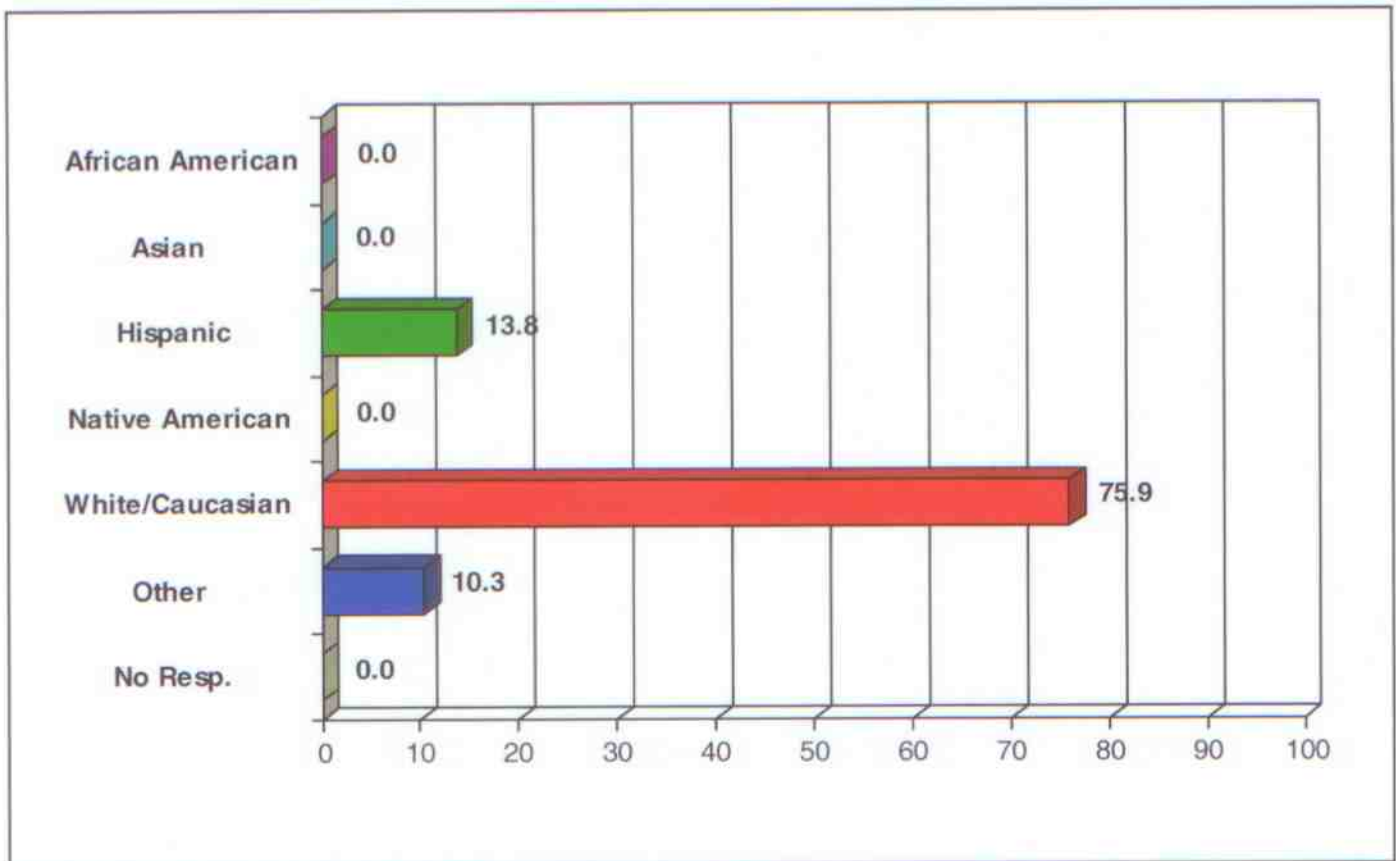

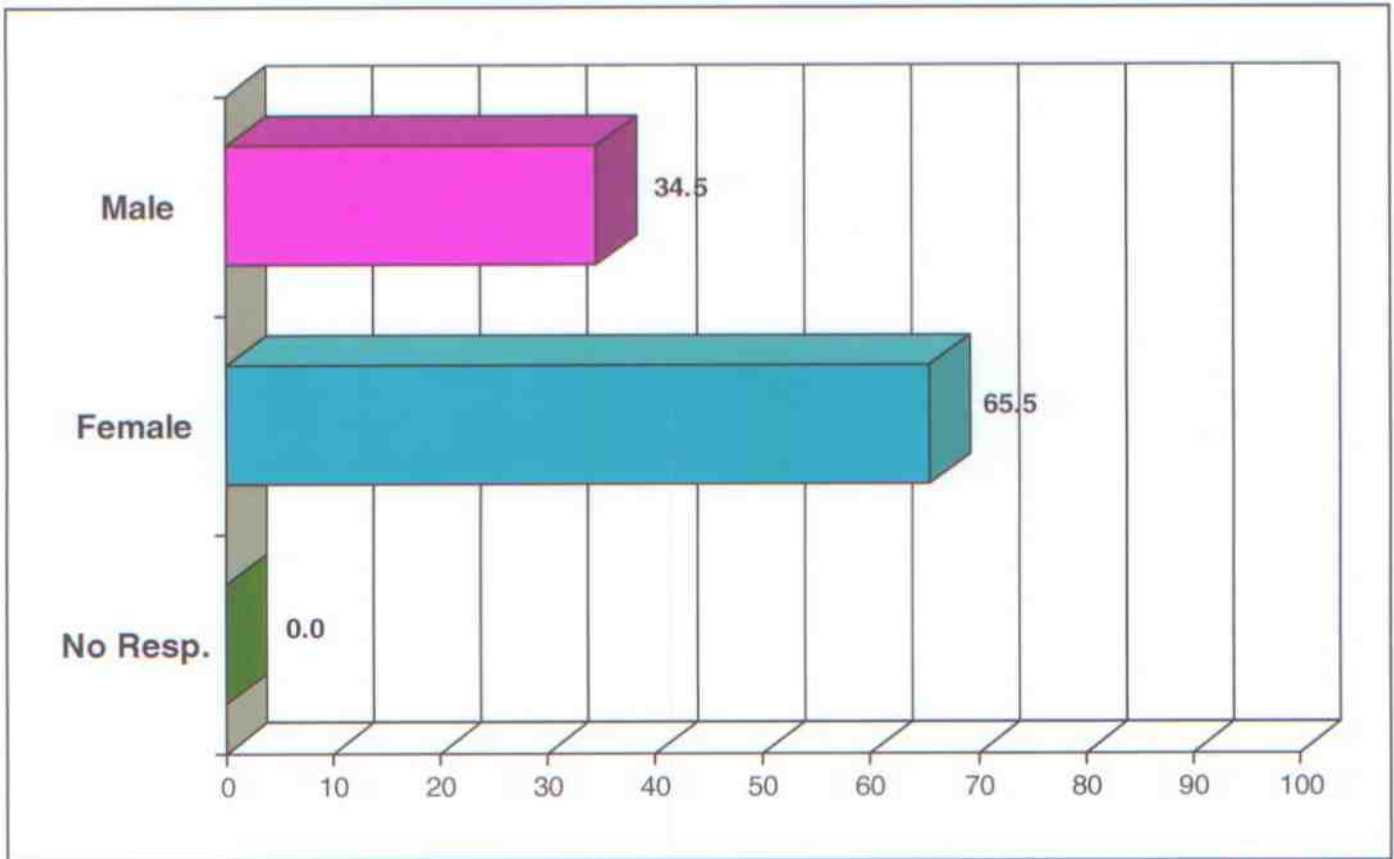

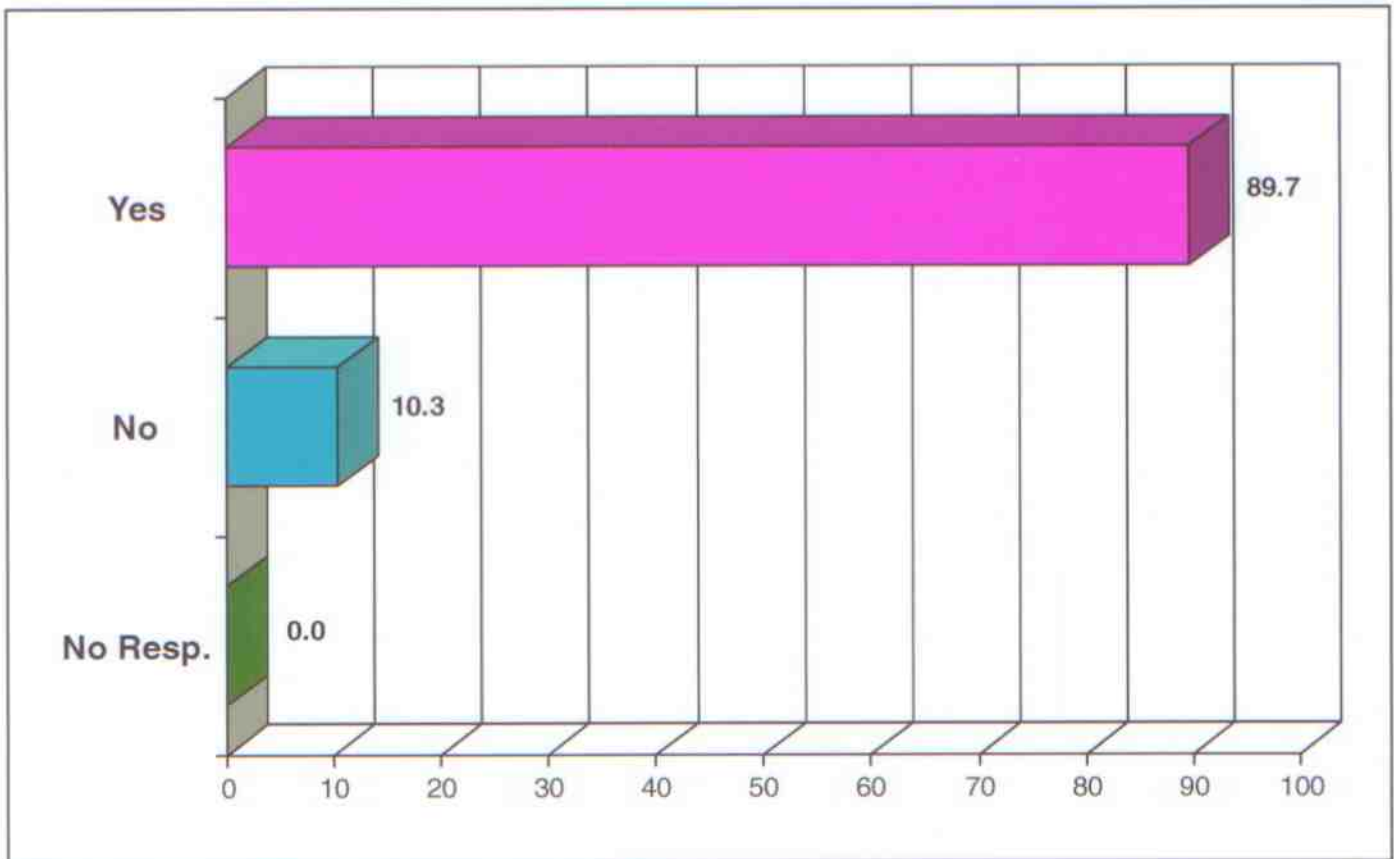

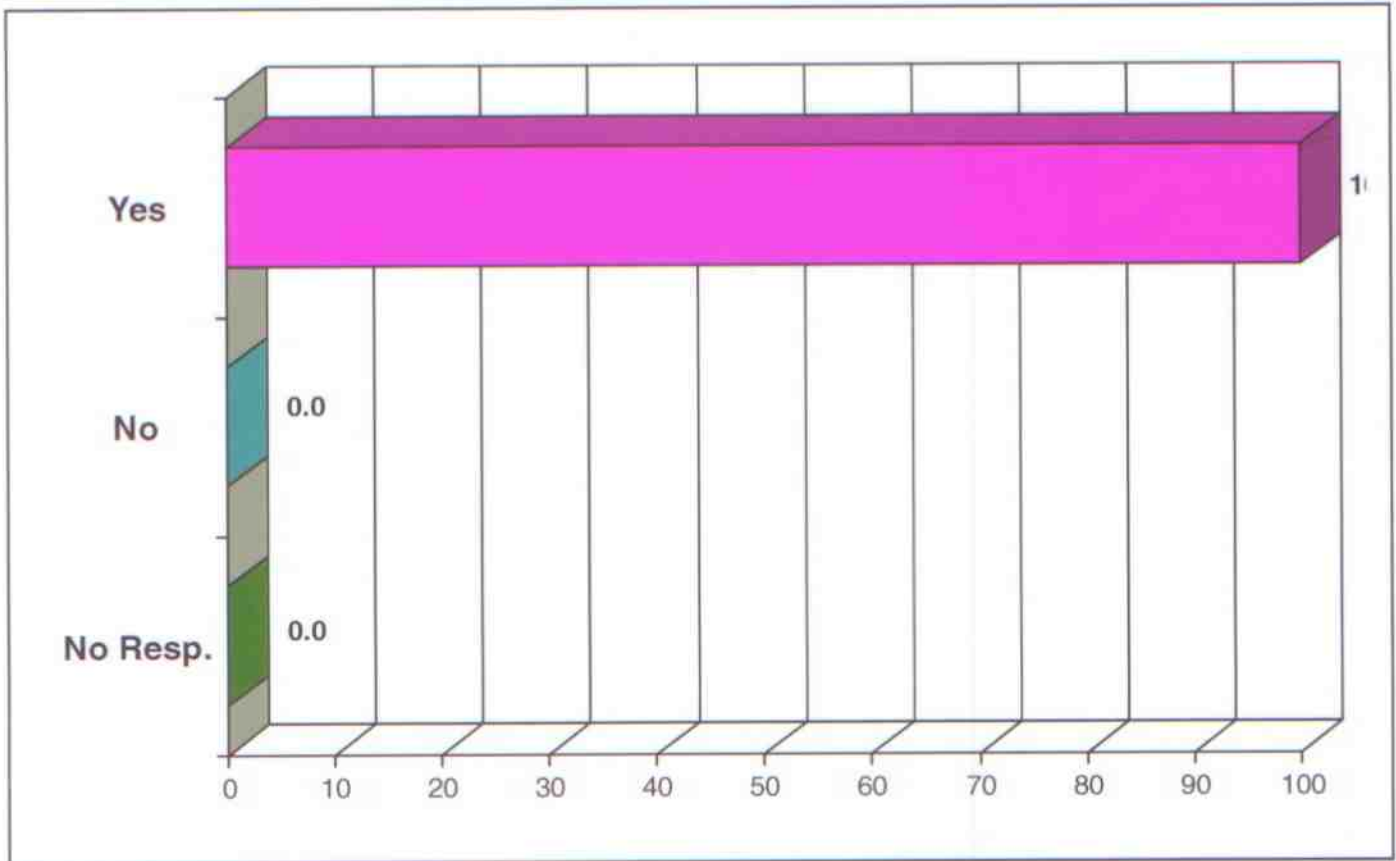

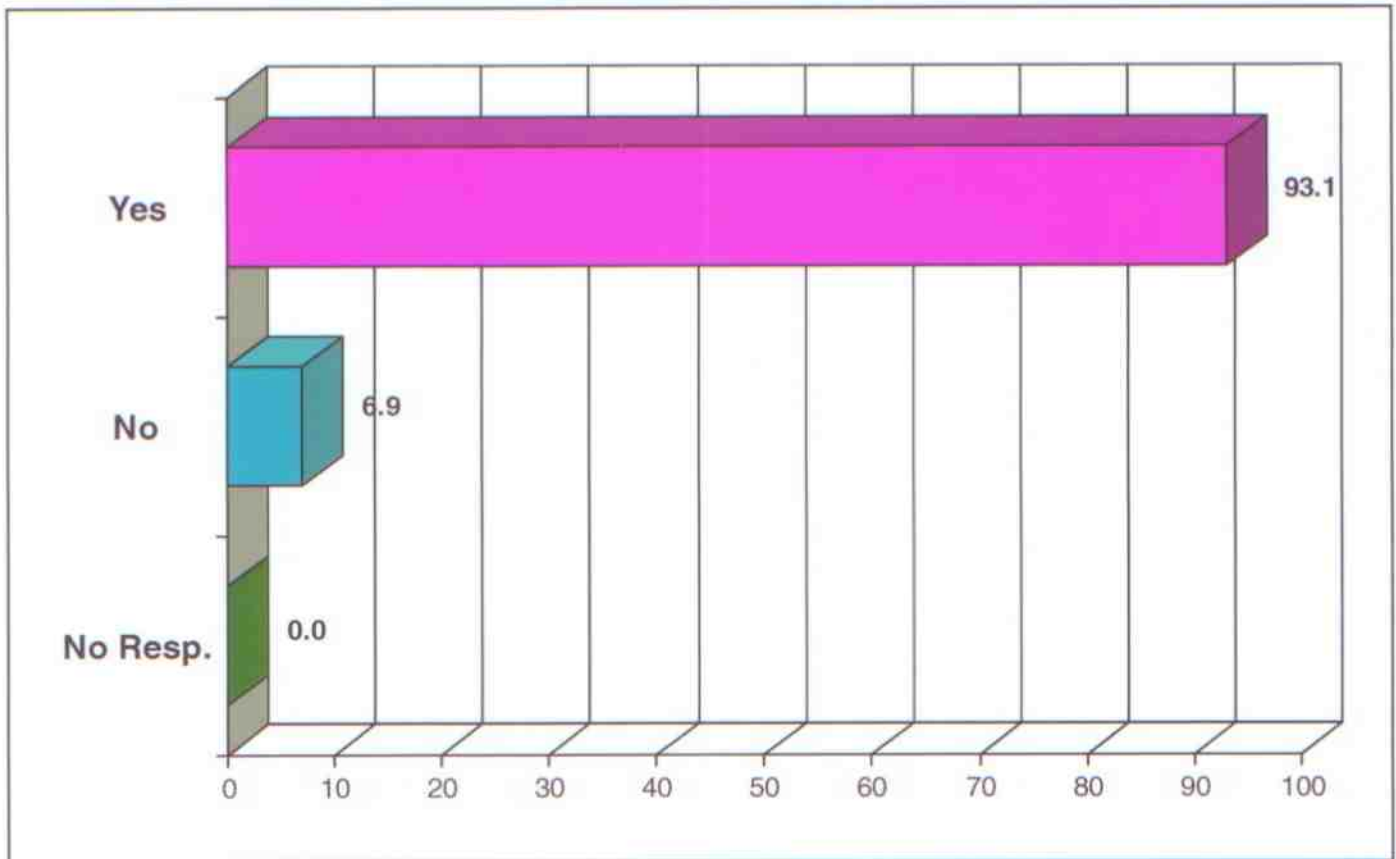

6. Were enough elective classes offered for you to explore different career opportunities?

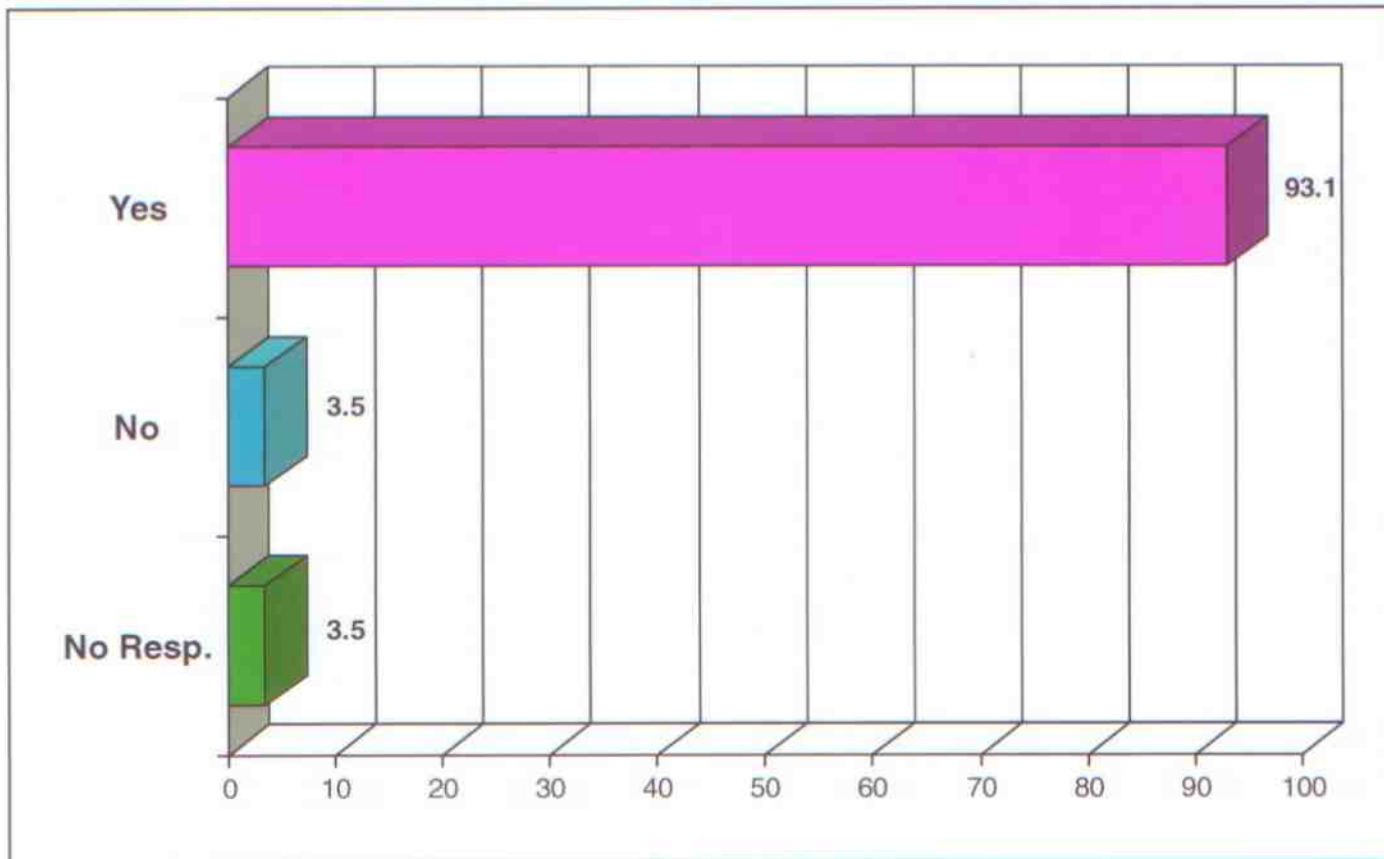
