- Explain the question itself
- Identify and describe the standards being assessed
- Identify and describe any rubrics used
- Identify and describe the proficiency descriptors and the numerical range
- Walk colleagues through a “guided discovery” using actual student work samples with annotations

Reading – In Texas ... and Fireball Physics

Writing – Everyday life, p. 6 – 23

Science – questions 4, 5, ball in free fall, 12, 15, 16 and 17
